The good news is, I already have some instruments that were ordered over the summer, and I will set them up for the children. Now is your chance to order your instrument if you have forgotten! If you have misplaced your order information, I am sending it out the link to the rental site. I look forward to hearing from you and to begin instilling a love of music in your children.

Our rental provider is Music & Arts. <https://www.musicarts.com/rentals/> . Use the school's zip code, 19116, to receive the correct pre-set information. ALL students will need a lesson book, an instrument, and if you can provide a music stand for home use. For string instruments (grade 3+), you should have been given sizing information already. If you have misplaced it, please email me and I will re-measure your child. (Grades 4+) Band instruments are one size fits all! You can shop elsewhere, but please do not buy Target or Chinese, cheap quality instruments. They are not worth it if they get damaged. Also, consider that for small string players, multiple instruments will have to be purchased as the child grows.
