Dear MaST Schools Families,

We wanted to provide a few additional details around some questions we are getting since our last update. Thank you for your patience and support and we will continue to update you with more information as things become more clarified on our end.

Refunds

Unfortunately, at this time, our staff is following Governor Wolf's mandated stay-at-home guidelines and are unable to access student account records and systems to process checks.

- **Class Trips:** We are aware that many trips are being canceled and that refunds will need to be issued. In addition to the fact that we're unable to process checks at this time, many of the trip locations are also closed and not able to process requested deposit refunds at this time. We will be sure to issue all refunds when we have the ability to do so and we appreciate your patience in the interim.
- **Before & Aftercare:** Money will either be refunded or credited towards a future month, at a date to be determined once we know when school will be back in session.
- **Club and Athletic Fees:** This will be determined at a later date once we know if/when clubs and athletics will resume this school year.

When the video is available, all students and parents will receive a Remind message. Students will be expected to request their courses for the next school year while at home.
